Example: Sherlock and Mycroft Holmes in the 1911 census.

Using TheGenealogist we can look for two boys with the surname of *Holmes* who had additionally been given the first names of the characters from Arthur Conan Doyle's novels.

From the Master Search we can then use the drop down menu to select that we want to search for a family. Entering the surname *Holmes* and first name of *Sherlock* we can then add his brother using the Add a family member.




